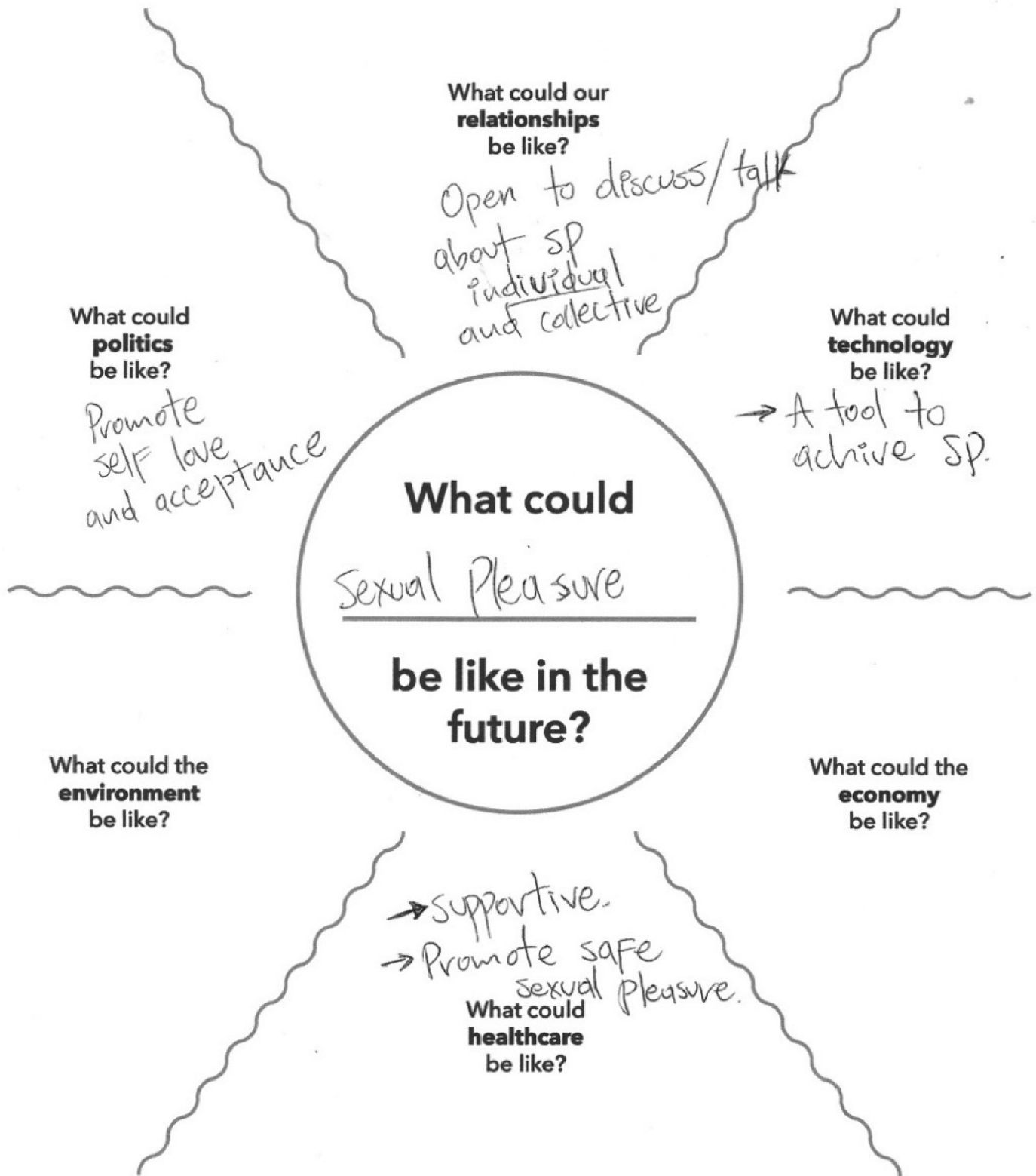

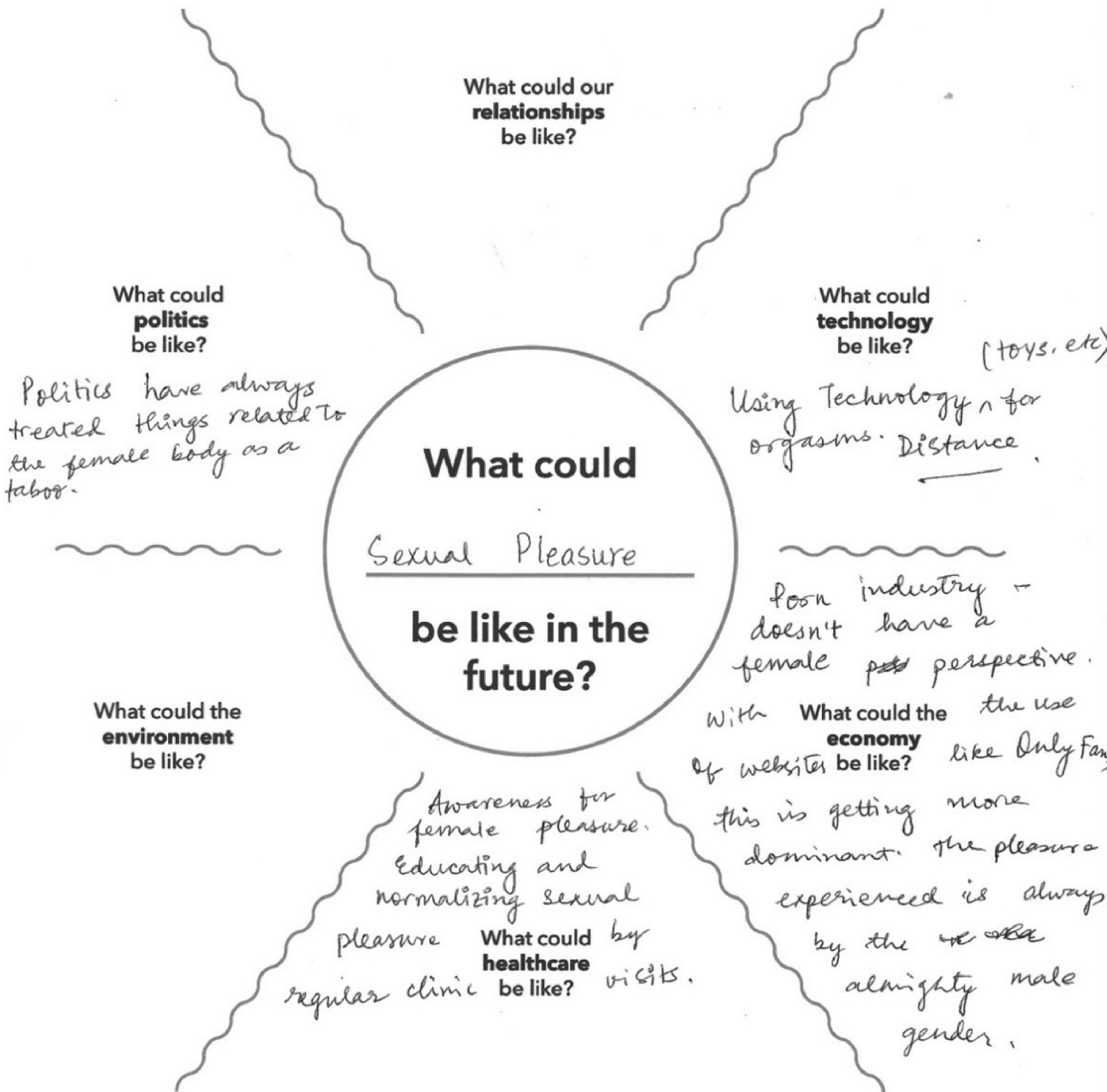

- more sex-based facilities that aren't demeaning (strip clubs)

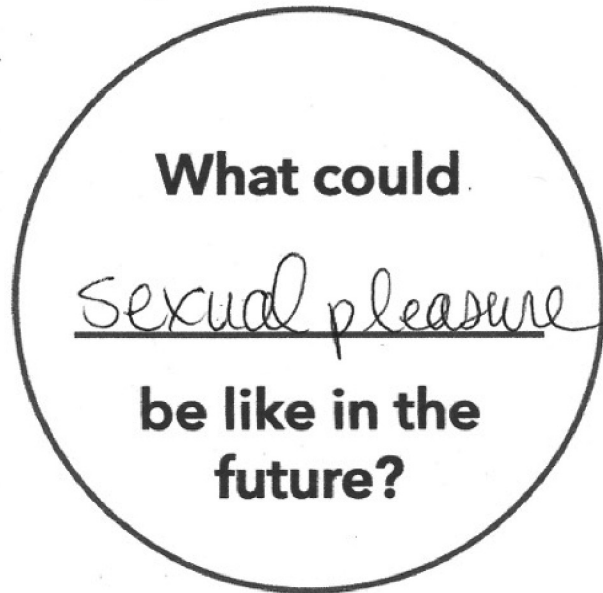
